5. All care about is Video TS folder
6. Version 0.9.3 for Leopard. Varies for OS.
7. Video different from motion pictures
8. Use to convert DVD to computer so watch on computer, iphone, etc. Use less battery on computer when watch on flash drive. Movie then only about 700 MB. QT keeps changing what works

1. Simple version of Handbrake. Shareware.
2. Ripdifferent Web site. 3.0 for Leopard. 2.66 for tiger. Keeps updating it as new anti-ripping comes on.
3. DVDs are regionalized. MTR can wipe out the regions.
4. Manual – looks good.
5. Redbox – DVDs for \$1.
6. In Apps, Ben has 3rd party apps as a folder. Why?
7. Can set what you want to extract
8. Archive stuff just want for a copy in case something breaks
9. Can remove junk selection on front of DVD – for twins
10. Once extracted, use Toast to burn a DVD using Video TS file Use DVX codec to make smaller. If want on computer, need to do nothing. If on iPhone, copy the file to the flash. 8GB flash drive now cost \$5. What do with old 512 MB drives? MKV format.
